

TERMS & CONDITIONS

A LEVEL EASTER REVISION COURSES 2017

LITE Regal's aim for Easter Revision Courses is to provide a stimulating working environment for examination preparation. For the welfare of all students the following conditions must be adhered to:

- 1. All registrations must be accompanied by fully completed application form and required payment. The booking will be officially confirmed by email.
- Applications and payments must be received in advance of tuition, no later than 24th March.
- 3. Late applications will be considered only if there are unfulfilled places on the course.
- 4. LITE Regal reserves the right to cancel any course if under-subscribed. In such circumstances students will offered an alternative course or obtain full refund of fees paid. Fees are not refundable for any other reason.
- 5. Non-residential students studying one subject only might be allocated a morning or afternoon session. We will inform students and parents of course timing in advance.
- 6. LITE Regal shall not be liable for loss or damage to personal property or injury to persons however caused, other than that where negligence on the part of the school is proved.
- 7. Drugs and alcoholic beverages may not be brought onto or consumed within any part of the school or accommodation. Failure to abide by this rule will result in student being removed from the course.
- 8. Smoking is not permitted within any part of the school, its grounds or accommodation.
- 9. LITE Regal reserves the right to remove any student who's behaviour is detrimental to the smooth running of the course.
- 10. Parents or guardians will be charged for any damage to the property caused by malice or neglect.
- 11. If for any reason student needs to leave LITE Regal during the course, they must obtain permission from the course Director. Residential students must obtain permission from Head of Pastoral Care.
- 12. LITE Regal may photograph or film courses and participants for marketing purposes. By agreeing to these terms & conditions LITE Regal presumes the consent unless it is notified in writing in advance of your child attending the course.
